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Participating in the seminar of heads of educational institutions meant for training candidates to succeed in various competitive examinations, the Chairman said.

My dear friends, I / am very happy to amongst you and would like to tell you how to achieve success in our aim by way of group discussions. // Such group discussions depend not merely on knowledge one enjoys in the subject chosen for the discussion or one's gift of the God but also /// on the ability of the candidate to inspire and motivate the group and carry the group-mates with him. Of course, knowledge of the subject as (1) well as power of expression, are indeed very important but they alone will not serve the purpose. We can say they are the foundations and / starting points. To build the edifice on the foundation and to reach the finishing point as definite winner from the beginning, one requires the leadership // quality.

This is the underlying secret for success in group discussions. You know why? Because that is a personality test as compared to other written /// or objective tests. To be brief, the candidate must create a strong and favourable impact on the group in which he is a member. This (2) alone will assure success. Please remember that with knowledge and power of expression, or for that matter even with mere power of expression alone, one / might be able

to create a strong impression on the group. If you speak with great fluency, authority and emphasis using flowery language for some // length of time you would certainly attract attention and make some impact on your audience. For achieving all these things, you should have good knowledge /// in English language. The demand for English language is growing day by day. This language is not confined to any individual country. All the countries (3) have recognized the growing importance of English even for the purpose of international economic and commercial transactions. They take a keen interest in promoting the / study of English.

In earlier months we did organize similar workshops, wherein the emphasis was made on the relationship between the student and teacher, not // forgetting the role of the parents. Under ideal conditions, true education could be imparted by parents and there should be minimum outside help. In other /// words parents are the first teachers. If character building is the highest destiny of any education worth the name then the foundation should be laid (4) at home. The parents, the teachers and the students must realise their responsibility. As education begins at home, the parents have the paramount duty of / shaping the formative years of a son or daughter. By the same logic the parents have a say in the making of any educational policy. // They must not think that their duty is over after sending their wards to a school or college. After all it is they who pay /// for their ward's education. Then should the parents not get back their money's worth? Educational experts may be efficient and proficient in dictating policies. But (5) ultimately the parents suffer or benefit by such policies.

Hence, it will go a long way in arranging some programmes, wherein the voice of parents / could be heard. They are like liaison officers between the teachers and the taught. They too should realise that they have a stake in their // enterprise and see that their children receive the best out of education imparted in different professional teaching and coaching institutes. For this purpose, I suggest /// that we should also organsize the parents association to hear their say and discuss educational policies and determine what is good for their wards. (6)


Dear Sirs,
